What are the risks or hazards involved?

- Tripping over clothes
- Trapped fingers in cupboards
- Broken toys /cutlery
- Scrapes /wounds from broken toys
- Choking on small pieces of equipment
- Age appropriate toys clothes

What can be done to reduce the risks

- Layout of equipment to ensure there is enough room for the children and adults to move freely to each activity
- Children taught how to use play equipment correctly
- Ensure clothes are not trailing or too big for children
- All toys are checked and cleaned on a regular basis
- Throw away damaged equipment
- Check home corner, prams, and cupboards for missing screws or throw away and fix if necessary.
- Supervise and monitor small children with the small wooden dolls furniture

- To monitor all toys
- Clean on a weekly basis
- Health safety policy
