Introduction to GDPR

Dear parents

There is a new EU data protection law coming into force from May 25th 2018 - it is called the *General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)*. The Government is currently updating the Data Protection Act (1998) to a new Data Protection Bill (2018).

The Club are already registered with the Information Commissioners Office and I have been working hard behind the scenes to make sure I am compliant with the GDPR. As part of the information sharing required by GDPR, The club will need to give you a copy of my new Privacy Notice

The Privacy Notice tells you:

- What information the club holds about you and your child/ren
- Why we hold this information - the legal basis for processing the information
- What we do with your personal information
- How long we will hold onto your information to help us comply with various statutory requirements.

The Daisy Club will also ask you to read the new Retention Policy and to complete a new Permission form which will help to ensure we share information with you effectively.
